

**American University Neighborhood Partnership  
Transportation and Parking Working Group Summary**

June 25, 2019

Key Discussion Points:

- Lighting Master Plan Presentation

Summary: The University contracted the Lighting Practice to create guidelines for new lighting around AU's main campus with a focus on creating a safe environment with adequate light levels, reduce contrasting, and minimizing shadows. AU took feedback on the lighting master plan including clearing up the boundaries shown in the presentation and how their lighting plans interface with the areas on the edge of campus.

The presentation continued with the discussion of AU's photometric study of the campus and what types of new lighting will likely replace the current light poles. The presentation also looked at two specific lighting revisions to the signage and Massachusetts Ave. and the South Campus walkways. The meeting ended with a question and answer session which examined how this lighting plan fits in with the overall campus planning process, how AU works with DDOT for the areas directly around the school for lighting coordination, and the specifics of the Washington Globe light pole which is common lighting around DC.
