American University Neighborhood Partnership Transportation and Parking Working Group Summary October 24, 2019

Key Discussion Points:

Summary: AU is working with Nelson/Nygaard to create a Transportation Demand Management (TDM) plan which interfaces with DDOT plans for the surrounding areas. Ideally these plans integrate both current and emerging modes of transport to provide a holistic approach. The group next looked at the new Zoning Commission regulations for campus planning. This process has been updated since the 2011 campus plan and will integrate the CTR study, AU's development plan and the revised student enrollment numbers.

The group then looked at the guiding principles and how they interface with the neighbor's priorities for transportation, suggestions included designated drop-off points for ride-share, continued enforcement of the Good Neighbor Policy and the impact of DDOT's proposed bike mobility lanes. In wrapping up, the group looked at a better way to access key info in the 2011 Campus Plan and areas from the campus planning process that they would like to improve upon.
