

What is a Campus Plan?

- A campus plan is a regulatory document required by the DC Zoning Commission for universities located in residentially zoned areas.
- Campus plans are roadmaps of <u>potential</u> construction projects and campus enhancements.
- Campus plans address five basic elements:
 - ✓ Enrollment
 - ✓ Facilities/Capital Projects
 - ✓ Student Housing
 - ✓ Student Conduct
 - ✓ Transportation
- Universities detail how they will manage these issues over the course of the plan.
- After a campus plan is approved and a university is ready to build a new project, they must reappear before the Zoning Commission for additional approvals and community input.
