


# Student Conduct



- Since September 23, 2019, we have received nine complaints containing reports of disruptive behavior.
- 7 reports from single family homes (AU Park, Spring Valley\*, Rockwood Parkway\*, Palisades, Tenleytown)
- 2 reports from apartment/condo communities (The Berkshire & Sutton Place)
- 4 reports were unactionable incomplete information/unidentified parties
- 3 reports were resolved with meeting with Office of the DOS and/or Fraternity & Sorority Life
- 2 reports were referred to the student conduct process
  - Both process involved charges made against individuals and the group/org.
  - 1 report resolved resulting in the disciplinary probation and a risk management plan for the organization
  - 1 report is currently still going through the process






