# Off-Campus Student Conduct

November 28, 2023

**For the period of September 2, 2023 – November 27, 2023, the Office of the Dean of Students has received 9 reports of disruptive off-campus behavior.**

**7 reports from single family homes:**

**AU Park – 2**

**Colony Hill – 2**

**Palisades – 1**

**Tenleytown – 2**

**2 reports regarding apartment/condo communities**

**McLean Gardens – 2**

**7 reports involved complaints of noise/parties/gatherings**

**2 reports involved concerns about the physical environment of the property**

**During the same period last year, there were 11 reports**

## **Actions Taken:**

**1 report was referred to Office of Student Accountability and Restorative Practices (OSARP)**

**7 reports were resolved through a meeting with the Dean of Students (DOS)**

**1 report did not involve any AU students**

**\* AUPD responded to and reported on 4 complaints regarding activity on Horace Mann Elementary playground not associated with any specific student**

**\*\*Follow-up from last meeting: There are 8 off-campus fraternity and sorority houses registered with the Center for Student Involvement**



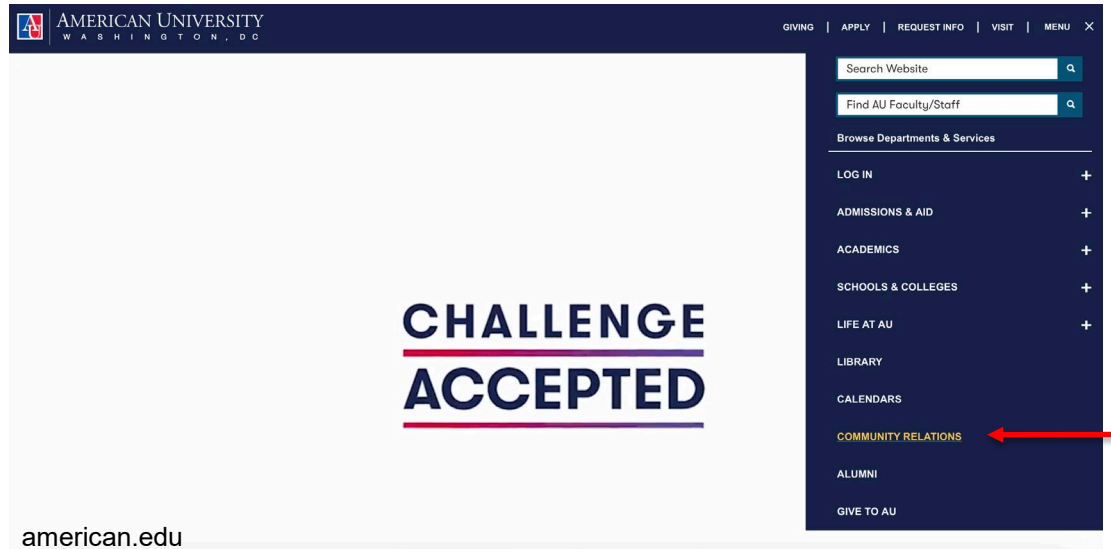

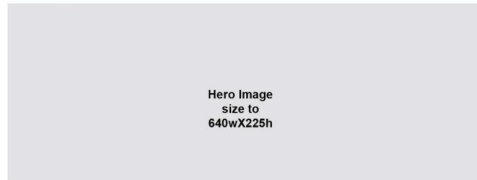

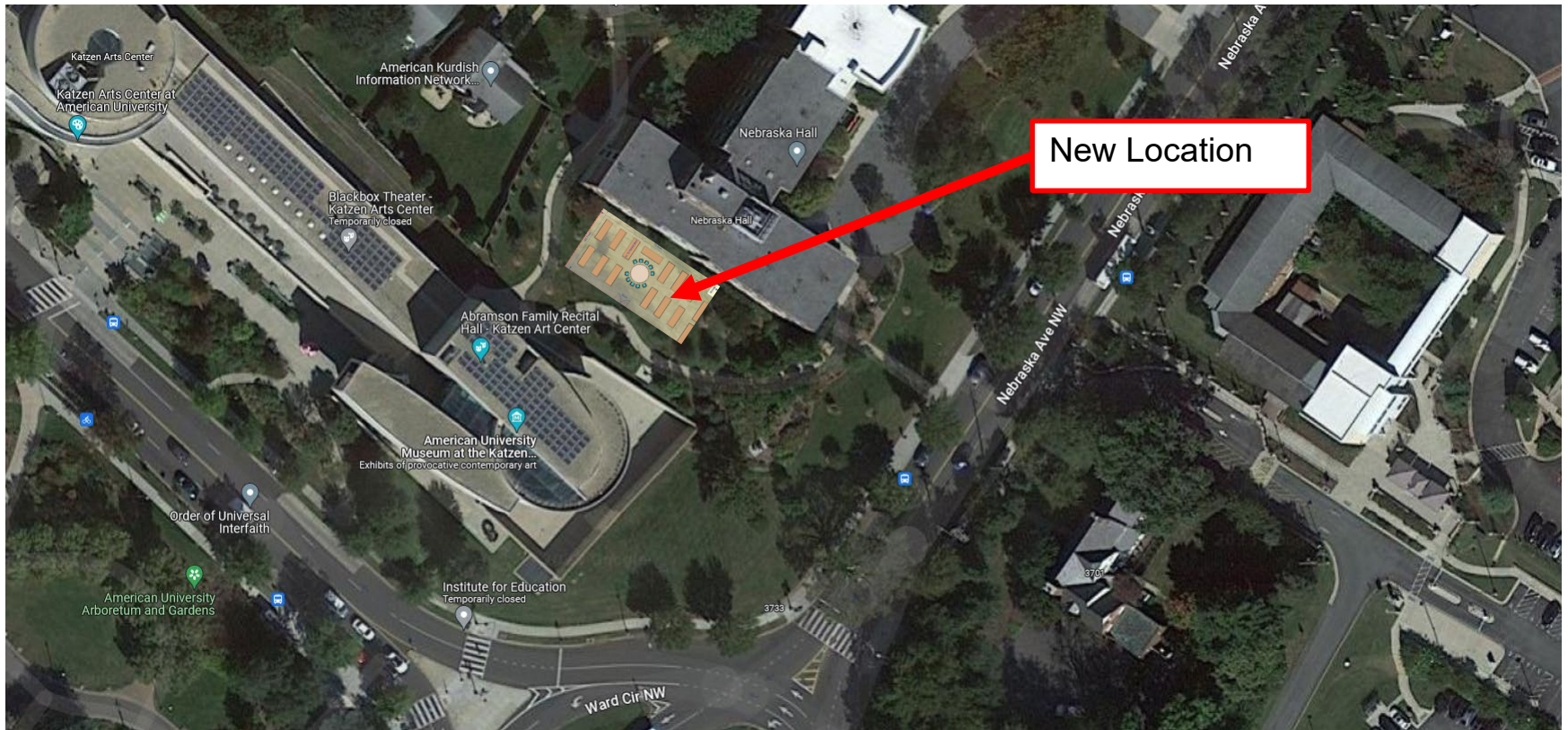






# Community Garden Relocation
