## Off-Campus Student Conduct December 7, 2021

For the period of August 15 – December 1, 2021, the Office of the Dean of Students has received 14 reports of disruptive off-campus behavior.

Thirteen reports from single family homes:

Tenleytown (4) – all about same residence Friendship Heights (4) – 3 reports about same residence Bethesda, MD (2) – both from same residence Spring Valley (1) Chevy Chase (1) Georgetown (1)

One report from apartment/condo communities: Cathedral Heights

Twelve reports involved complaints of noise, large gatherings, alcohol

One report involved graffiti/tagging/vandalism

#### **ACTION:**

- Four reports (same residence) are pending receipt of additional info
- Three reports were resolved through a meeting with the Dean of Students
- Two reports were referred to Student Conduct for adjudication
- One report was resolved by building/property management intervention
- Two reports were not actionable due to insufficient information
- One report was not actionable due to no students living at address
- One report was not actionable due to neighbor request for no action



### Progress – Exterior







- AU currently has a total of 12,525 students.
- Due to COVID-related impacts, AU is experiencing short-term enrollment developments that will return to historic trends in the spring semester.
  - There was a higher than usual number of fulltime students (318) that elected to delay graduation by a semester and return to campus in fall 2021. Many of these students wanted to finish their college experience on campus and in person.
  - Due to COVID-19 related restrictions in other countries, many Study Abroad students were not allowed to travel internationally this semester. Only 240 study abroad students traveled this fall, compared to 400 in previous years. AU anticipates 438 students studying abroad in spring of 2022 based on student expressed interest.

- AU remains committed to mitigating the impacts of our students on our neighbors.
- In fall 2021, there are approximately 1,529 off-campus students that reside in the 20016 and 20008 zip codes a decrease of 20% from fall of 2020.
  - 2,289 students in fall 2019
  - 1,919 students in fall 2020
  - 1,529 students in fall 2021
- As of 12/1/21 there have been 14 neighbor complaints about off-campus student behavior which indicates that there has not been an increase in adverse activity.
