

## Student Conduct Update

Since March 3, 2020, we have received 3 complaints containing reports of disruptive behavior.

- 2 reports from single family homes (Upper Chevy Chase & Tenleytown/Friendship Heights)
- 1 report from apartment/condo communities (Berkshires)
- O reports were unactionable incomplete information/unidentified parties/unresponsive reporting parties
- 1 report was resolved with meeting with Office of the DOS.
- 1 report was resolved by Athletics coach/staff
- 1 report referred to Student Conduct and is currently in progress

For the same reporting period in 2018-2019, there were 3 complaints.


