Student Conduct Update

REPORTS:

Since September 11, 2020, we have received 18 complaints containing reports of disruptive behavior.

- 15 reports from single family homes:
 - ✓ Location Unknown [4]
 - ✓ Spring Valley [3]
 - ✓ AU Park [2]
 - ✓ Palisades, Cathedral Heights, Georgetown, Foxhall, Friendship Heights, Cleveland Park
- 3 reports from apartment/condo communities (Berkshires, Alban Towers, The Greenbriar)

Student Conduct Update

ACTION:

- 7 reports were made anonymously (4 were through the RAVE app on Halloween)
 - We have reason to believe 5 reports came from other students about their peers
- 11 reports included the name of the reporting party. Office of the Dean of Students (DOS) followed up with each report and met with students.
- For all reports where students were identified, the students met with staff in the DOS.
- In some cases where students were not identified, a follow-up letter was sent to all students in designated community.
- No reports were referred to Student Conduct.
- 1 report was resolved in conjunction with the Athletic Department.
- ALL reports were related to COVID-19 regulations – mask wearing, gatherings, and social distancing. Some of these reports including concerns around noise and/or alcohol.
- *For the same reporting period in 2019-2020, there were 9 complaints.*
