Abstract:

John Pielemeier served in multiple positions with the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) between 1970 and 1994. After he retired from USAID, Pielemeier became an independent consultant. This collection documents Pielemeier's work in international development with the USAID in Latin America, Africa, and Asia between 1973 and 1994 and his work in various projects and roles as an independent consultant between 1994 and 2015.

Collection Description

Biographical Note

John Pielemeier (b. 1944–) served in the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) from 1970 to 1994. After completing a degree in Foreign Service from Georgetown University and graduating with his master's from the University of Chicago, Pielemeier volunteered with the Peace Corps in Cote d'Ivoire. He began working with USAID in the International Development Intern program in 1971 in Brazil. While there, he participated in designing a loan for a health organization in northern Brazil and working on the "Food for Peace" program. Pielemeier then joined the USAID Africa Bureau in 1974 where he worked on project development and aid in drought recovery/prevention through improved irrigation systems and agricultural practices. In 1977 he joined the Office of Southern Africa Regional Coordinator (OSARC) where he worked on building infrastructure and agricultural projects. Pielemeier left OSARC in 1982 and returned to the U.S. to work in the USAID Washington Office of the Administrator, where he worked as the Special Assistant to Counselor Buster Brown and handled policy issues, rebudgeting projects, and evaluations of project proposals. Pielemeier then served as the Director of the Office of South Asia between 1986 and 1989. As Director, Pielemeier focused on flood management and responses to natural disasters. In 1989, Pielemeier left USAID to attend the Industrial College of Armed Forces. Pielemeier returned to USAID in 1991 and served as a Senior Foreign Service Officer in Brazil and worked on family planning, climate change, and HIV/AIDS until his retirement 1994.

After his retirement, Pielemeier worked as an independent consultant in various roles until 2018. As a consultant, he led teams designing and evaluating international development projects for organizations including USAID, Global Environment Fund (GEF), the United Nations (UN), the Packard Foundation, and a variety of other organizations and consulting firms. Pielemeier held roles as a team leader managing large scale projects for numerous organizations and purposes, adapting to what each mission called for. In roles where he was an evaluator, Pielemeier reviewed USAID projects that could be improved and assessed for necessary changes. As a consultant, Pielemeier designed and created new loans and grant proposals for multiple governments throughout Latin America and Africa. As a conservationist with the United Nations in 1998, Pielemeier evaluated the impact of development projects on the environment. Working as a Design Strategist, Pielemeier was able to create his own plans for progress and international development for different clients and governments. Pielemeier's work as a Senior Fellow

(1995-1996) with the World Wildlife Fund aided in key findings to better promote conservation efforts in Latin America.

Evaluator

This collection documents John Pielemeier's career as a USAID employee between 1970 and 1994 and his career as an independent consultant between 1994 and 2018. This collection includes reports, publications, and papers written and collected by Pielemeier.

The bulk of this collection contains materials related to Pielemeier's work as an independent consultant and his commitment to working with environmental conservation. Pielemeier assessed the success and failures of different sustainability programs and project plans in order to create a response for how these missteps could be remedied. Additionally, the majority of the documents produced during his USAID

tenure come from his position as the Special Assistant to the Counselor at the Washington Office of the USAID Administrator. Pielemeier's work was policy oriented during this period, as the documents all pertained to USAID's positions on different forms of economic assistance. Significant topics appearing in this collection include various global health and development projects and assessments, government aid to foreign nations, and global conservation efforts. The materials in this collection are textual and include mission updates, evaluations, aid and project plans, grant proposals, assessments, evaluations, reviews, response strategies on international development and conservation efforts, and final reports.
