Dear Students,

Please note that the U.S. President Trump's executive order titled <u>Protecting the</u> <u>Nation from Terrorist Entry into the United States by Foreign Nationals</u> mentions seven countries (Iran, Iraq, Libya, Somalia, Sudan, Syria and Yemen) for the 90-day visa ban, but is not very clear about the impact on citizens of those countries who are currently in the U.S.

If you plan to leave the U.S. with intent to return to resume your studies, or you are currently outside the U.S. and intend to travel to the U.S. to study, please consult with an experienced immigration lawyer prior to making travel plans.
