

## Peer-Assisted Student Support (PASS) Program, Student Academic Services <u>Tutoring Policy</u>

- 1. Students must arrive to their scheduled appointment on time.
- 2. If students need to cancel their appointment, they must do so, at least three (3) hours prior to the appointment.
  - a. Students must email <u>tutoring@american.edu</u> or their Tutor to cancel their appointment within the three-hour window.
- 3. If students are five to ten minutes late to their tutoring appointment, they will be marked as missed and receive a NO-SHOW notification.
- 4. If a student accumulates three (3) NO-SHOW appointments in a semester, their online tutoring access, WCOnline, will be disabled. To reactivate their WCOnline account, the student must contact Student Academic Service staff at <a href="mailto:tutoring@american.edu">tutoring@american.edu</a>.
- 5. Students must come to tutoring prepared with lecture notes, assignments, textbooks, and any necessary tools to receive assistance.
- 6. Do as much of your work as you can before arriving to tutoring sessions.
- 7. Students should review assignments, clarify concepts that are confusing, coordinate when assignments are due and develop timelines to complete their work successfully.
- 8. Come ready to work. Turn off or silence your cell phone.
- 9. Leave enough time to get help and learn. Come to tutoring when you will have enough time to use the information from your Tutor to make your work better.
- 10.Students will be an active participant in tutoring. Tutors will not do your work for you or give you answers.
- 11. Ask questions and listen to suggestions. Be patient and considerate with regards to yourself and your Tutors.
- 12. Tutors are not to work on homework that will be turned in for a grade or take-home exams. Tutors are to provide similar problems as examples but are not to assist on solving work to be graded.
- 13.Disrespectful behavior towards Tutors and staff will not be tolerated. If reported, you will be asked to meet with Student Academic Services staff.
- 14. Students are expected to follow the AU Student Conduct Code in tutoring sessions and in all Student Academic Services.
